

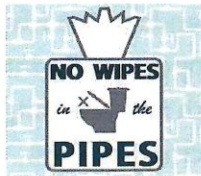
## Leaf Pick up

Middlebury Town Ordinance 313 prohibits outdoor burning. Leaf collections for Town residents starts in the middle of October. Leaves need to be raked out to the curb, not on the roadway. Sticks and grass clippings will not be picked up. Sticks and grass clippings can be taken out to the Public Works building at 125 York Drive  
Hours are 6:15 AM - 7:00 PM



### REMINDERS:

Items that should **not** be put down the toilets/drains include any type of wipes (baby wipes, even if it says they are flushable wipes)



Dental floss, diapers, cooking grease, medications, and cotton products. These items should be placed into your trash container.

The Town contracts with Allied Waste. One container is provided and picked up by Allied Waste on Monday or Tuesday. All trash needs to fit inside the container and the container placed out by the curb by 6:30 AM on your scheduled pick up day. If your trash cart is damaged, or a wheel or lid is broken, contact the

Town Hall at

574-825-1499 and we will contact Allied for a replacement.



Twice a year in the Spring and the Fall the Town has clean up days where you can take large items out to the dumpsters at 125 York Drive, the dates will be posted on your water/wastewater bills.

If you sign up you will receive Alerts regarding Police Activity, road closure/Detours, severe Weather Watch and Boil water orders.

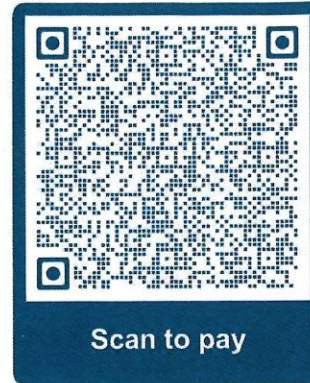

## Water & Wastewater Info

On your water bill you will notice it includes a QR code that will take you directly to the Town web page. You will be able to pay your bill on-line through Invoice Cloud or sign up for e-billing. When you register, on your address, only put the numbers do not include the street name. There is a \$2.95 charge to pay your bill this way. Invoice Cloud accepts Credit, Debit cards and Pay Pal. Other ways to pay your bill is at the Town Hall at 418 N. Main Street, we only take cash, check, and money orders. There is a drop box outside the doors if you want to pay after hours. You can pay at any First State Bank location. The Town also offers an ACH (an automated electronic payment), go to our Web page under Water Department to get the ACH form, you can bring it into the office or e-mail it to [info@middleburyin.com](mailto:info@middleburyin.com) to get this set up
